Floor load

The permissible point load on a base area of 50 cm by 50 cm (distance approx. 1.50 m) is 5 t (50 kN, ground pressure 200 kN/m^2).

Floor protection

To protect the existing floor, all exhibition areas will be provided with floor protection. This will be implemented exclusively by Messe München GmbH. The costs will be invoiced to exhibitors according to the area concerned.

The contours of the stand areas are adapted to the floor protection grid. Detailed planning is coordinated via the Site Manager.

Construction height

Maximum construction and advertising height: 10 m Deviating construction heights are checked individually.
